

Verses to meditate and pray on that coincide with the Topic of Prayer for each day

Sunday Prayer Focus: Repentance and Forgiveness

- Psalm 51:1-2, 4, 7-9

“Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness, according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. (4) Against You, You only have I sinned and done this great evil in Your sight. That You may be found just when You speak and blameless when You judge. (7-9)Purge me with hyssop and I shall be clean, wash me and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me hear joy and gladness, that the bones You have broken may rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities. ”

- Matthew 6:14,15

“For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”

- Acts 3:19

“Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,”

- 1 John 1:8-10

“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. ”

Monday Prayer Focus: God’s Spirit and Glory Poured Out/Revival/Baptism of the Holy Spirit

- Exodus 33:17-19

“So the Lord said to Moses, ‘I will also do this thing that you have spoken, for you have found grace in My sight, and I know you by name.’ And he said, Please show me Your Glory. And He said, ‘I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious and I will have compassion.’”

- Isaiah 43:18,19

“Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing, now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.”

- Ezekiel 37:9-10

“Also He said to me, ‘Prophecy to the breath, prophesy son of man and say to the breath, “Thus says the Lord God: ‘Come from the four winds, O breath and breathe on these slain, that they may live.’” So I prophesied as He commanded me, breathe came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army.”

“I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.”

Tuesday Prayer Focus: Souls/Youth/Children

- Matthew 19:13-14

“Then the little children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and pray, but the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, ‘Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven’”.

- Mark 16:15,16

“And He said to them, ‘Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.’”

- Luke 15:4, 6-7,10

“What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? (6) And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!’ I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who needs no repentance. (10) Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

- Luke 19:9-10

“And Jesus said to him, ‘Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham; for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.’”

Wednesday Prayer Focus: Church Direction/Churches of our Nation/Persecuted Church

- Proverbs 29:18

“Where there is no vision, the people perish;”

- Joel 2:18 &19,23-25, 26&27

“Then the Lord will be zealous for His land, and pity His people. The Lord will answer and say to His people, ‘Behold, I will send you grain and new wine and oil, and you will be satisfied by them; I will no longer make you a reproach among the nations. (23) Be glad then you children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God, for He has given you the former rain faithfully, and He will cause the rain to come down for you, the former rain and the latter rain of the *first month*. (25) So will I restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten. (26) You shall eat plenty and be satisfied and praise the name of the LORD your God....and My people shall never be put to shame. Then you shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, I am the LORD your God and there is no other. My people shall never be put to shame.’”

- Hebrews 13:3

“Remember the prisoners as if chained with them, those who are mistreated, since you yourselves are in the body also.”

- Revelation 22:12-14, 16&17

“And behold I am coming quickly and My reward is with Me, to give to everyone according to his work. I am the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last. Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. (16) I Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star. And the Spirit and the bride say ‘Come!’ and let him who hears say ‘Come!’ and let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.”

Thursday Prayer Focus: Healing/Deliverance

- Psalm 91:2-3, 14-16

"I will say of the LORD, 'He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in Him will I trust. Surely He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence. '(14-16) 'Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him, I will set him on high, because he has known My name. He shall call upon Me and I will answer him ...I will deliver him..."

- Isaiah 53:4-5

"Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows, yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed."

- Luke 9:1-2, 6

"Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. (6) So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere."

- Colossians 1:13-14 , 2:9-10

"He has delivered us from the power of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (2:9-10) For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power."

Friday Prayer Focus: Day of Prayer and Fasting for Breakthroughs in our Church Families

- Isaiah 58:6, 8-9

"Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? (8-9) Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily and your righteousness shall go before you, the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call and the LORD will answer, you will cry and He will say 'Here I am'".

- 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

“For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.”

- Matthew 11:28-30

“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”
